Course: Latin 2

Essential learning outcomes: After successfully completing this course, students will be able to:

1. read and analyze selected authentic materials within the context of the acquired vocabulary and grammar.
2. demonstrate a knowledge of vocabulary, inflectional systems, and syntax appropriate to an intermediate Latin reading level.
3. review and master basic and intermediate grammatical structures.
4. demonstrate reading comprehension by answering questions in English about short passages of Latin.
5. acquire information about the Greco-Roman world by reading passages of Latin with a culturally authentic setting.
6. acquire knowledge of aspects of the culture and history of the Roman world
7. show evidence of becoming lifelong learners by understanding a specialized vocabulary in professional fields and such fields as government and politics, and its use in the media.
8. demonstrate an intermediate knowledge of the Latin roots, prefixes and suffixes by recognizing them in English words of Latin origin.
9. demonstrate an understanding of intermediate language patterns of English as they relate to the structure of Latin.
